SUBJECT: **2026–2027 Pathways to Career Opportunities Grant — Grow Your Own Teacher Registered Apprenticeship Program (PCOG-GYO) — Florida Department of Education Grants — Funding Opportunity/Webinar Schedule**

The purpose of this sub-initiative is to increase the supply of qualified teachers by creating a teacher pipeline for Florida. It is designed to encourage partnerships between eligible applicants and participating employers (Florida school districts, charter schools and charter management organizations) to provide an innovative, no-cost pathway to the teaching profession for registered teacher apprentices.

The funds for this grant are appropriated in the 2026 General Appropriations Act (GAA) as a sub initiative to the Pathways to Career Opportunities Grant (PCOG).

Eligible applicants include public Florida College System (FCS) institutions, State University System (SUS) institutions and Independent Colleges and Universities of Florida (ICUF) with a baccalaureate-level state-approved initial teacher preparation program (ITP) approved by the Florida Department of Education.
